What is the evidence for the resurrection?

• 1. The empty tomb.

The stone was rolled away.

Peter and John and the women saw that the tomb was empty.

The grave clothes were intact.

The empty tomb.

- Unbelievers say:
- Jesus did not really die.
- The disciples stole Him.
- The authorities stole Him.
- Robbers stole Him.

2. The post resurrection appearances.

Did the disciples hallucinate?

More than eleven appearances over a six week period.

• He appeared in different settings to a variety of people including more than 500 at one time.

 The nature of the appearances: He ate with them, talked with them, showed them His scars etc.

3. The transformation of the disciples.

• From being frightened men, hiding in a locked room from the authorities, they burst out on to the streets, preaching Christ.

• Each disciple was closely identified with Christ, many of them dying a martyrs death.

 From them grew a collection of men and women who were passionately committed to Christ and spread His fame throughout the then-known world.

4. Two thousand years of history.

 What began in a small country in the Middle East has been taken to every corner of the world.

• There are now 2.38 billion Christians in the world, 1/3 of its population.

• There is currently incredible growth in the Southern Hemisphere especially, with major people groups also turning to Christ.

What are the benefits that come to us?

• He defeated death, our great enemy, Romans 6:9.

His resurrection ratifies His death.

• He justifies us, Romans 4:25.

• Because He lives we shall live also, John 14:19.

What are the benefits that come to us?

• He brings us salvation, Romans 10:9.

He has given us a new birth, 1 Peter 1:3.

• He is the judge of all men, Acts 17:13.

• He is Lord of both the dead and the living, Romans 15:9.

What are the benefits that come to us?

He makes us spiritually fruitful, Romans 7:4.

We are seated with Christ in heavenly places, Ephesians 2:6.

• He gives life to our bodies, Romans 8:11.

• There is hope of a resurrection to all, Acts24:15, John 5:29.
